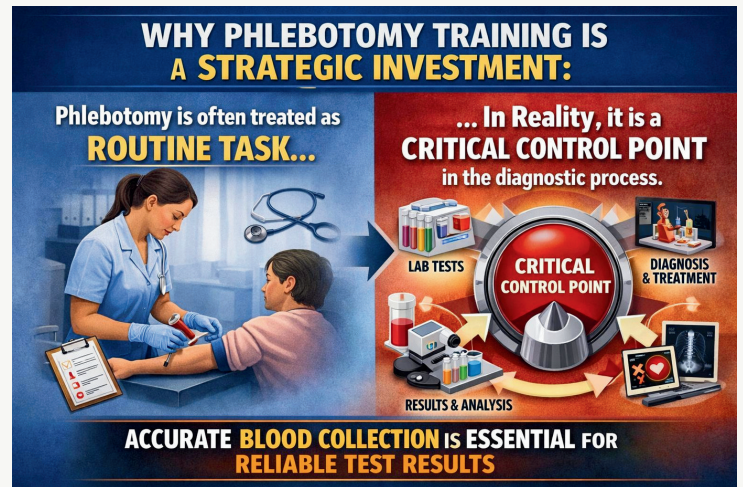
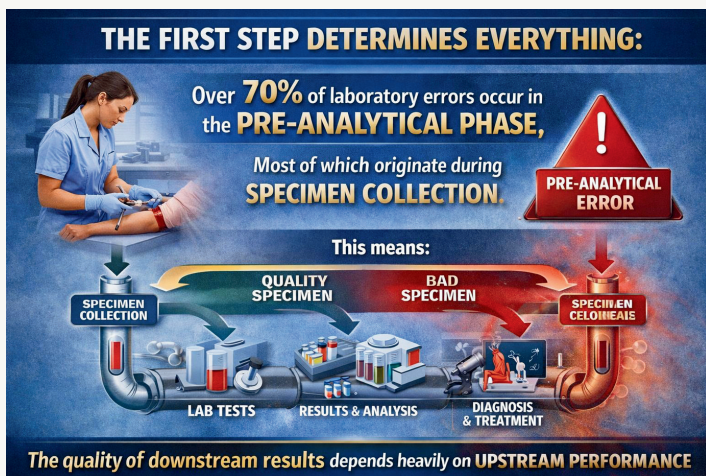


Why Phlebotomy Training Is a Strategic Investment
